RESEARCH ORGANIZATION:

The research was conducted by the CVVM research team as part of the research "Our Society 2018". The data were collected by the CVVM interviewer network.

Research parameters:

1078 persons representing the population of the Czech Republic older than 15 years were asked. Quotas used for respondent's selection were gender, age and education. The territorial representativeness of the sample is maintained by the construction of the interviewer network, where the checked characters are the size of the place of residence and regions.

Population parameters correspond to the structure of the population of the Czech Republic broken down by socio-demographic characteristics (sex, education, age) and by territory. Overall, we can say that the sample of respondents is representative because its composition corresponds to the whole population (with a tolerance of minimal deviations).

A total of 240 interviewers took part in the field data collection and rated the interviewing situation very well on average. Due to the good quality of the completed questionnaires, all interviews were included in the processing.

The sample shows a good level of representativity and has not been weighted.

Method of data collection:

Standardized interview. The data were collected by trained interviewers of the CVVM interviewing network.
